We also work in collaboration with **Charles Russell solicitors**, connecting clients to specialist legal advice and practical, sector-specific knowledge.

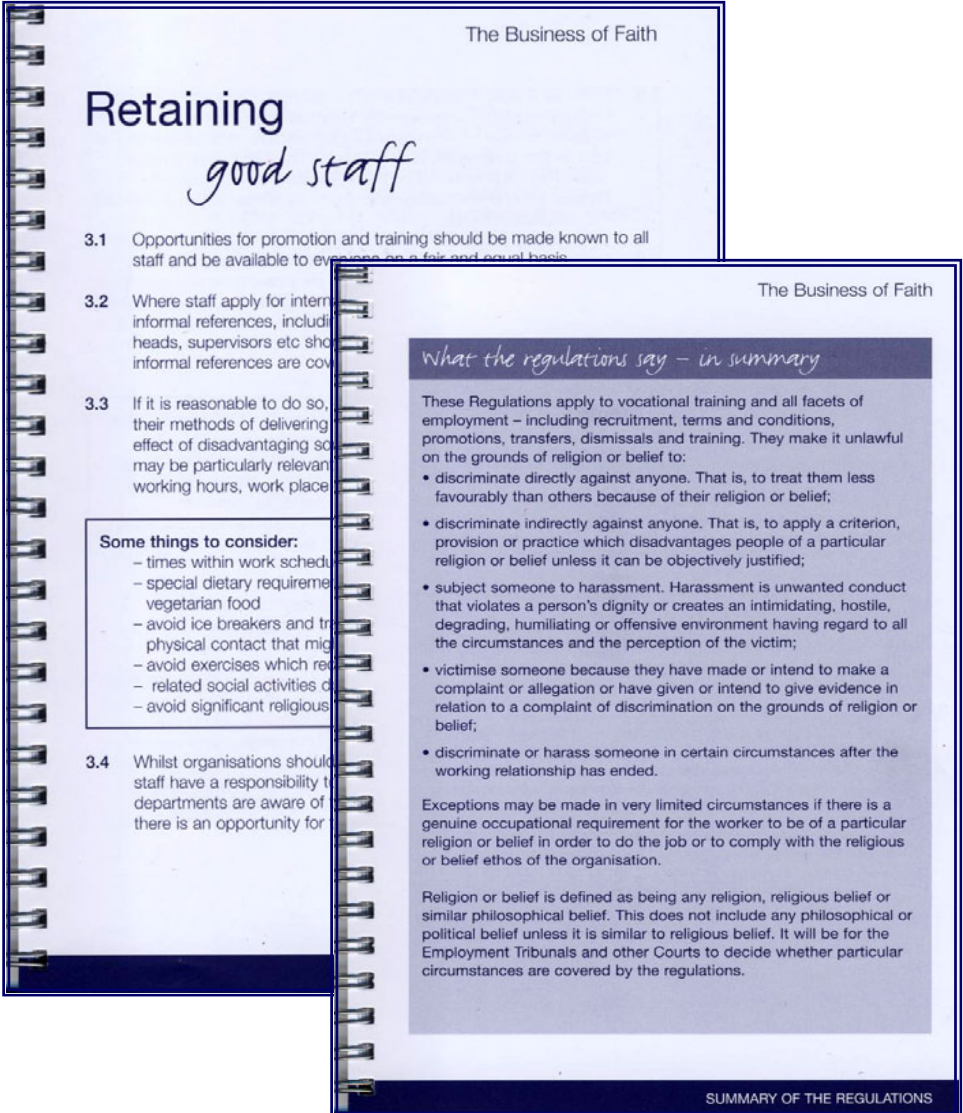
Events
